- - The Presidential Decree No. 809 /1975 concerning the issuing of the executive bylaws of the university regulations law and its amendments,
- The Ministerial Decree No. 256 / 1993 concerning the issuing of the internal bylaws of the Faculty of Tourism and Hotels at University of Sadat City and its amendment,
- The approval of University of Alexandria University Council in its session dated on 28/03/1995,

- The Decree of the Supreme Council of Universities in its session dated on 16/04/1994 concerning deputizing Prof. Minister of Higher Education and Head of the Supreme Council of Universities in approving the issuing of the Internal Bylaws of University Faculties and Institutes and their amendments after getting the approval of the competent university education sectors committees.

The enclosed Faculty of Tourism and Hotels at University of Sadat City internal bylaws become effective and any contradictory clause or condition is considered null and void.

All competent authorities should implement this decree which shall be published in the official newspaper.
