Master's Degree Stage

Conditions of obtaining the Master's Degree:

- He has obtained the bachelor degree of law or its equivalent from one of the Egyptian Universities or an equated degree from one of the recognized foreign Universities.
- He has obtained one of the postgraduate diplomas granted by the faculties of law in the Egyptian Universities or its equivalent.
- He has carried out for one year at least innovated researches on a topic approved by the council of the postgraduate studies based on the proposal of the faculty's council.
- The student chooses the subject matters of his dissertation provided that it is connected with the diploma exam successfully passed by him.
- The student presents the registration of the subject matter of the master's degree to the Dean of the faculty. Then, it is submitted to the faculty's council after taking the opinion of the competent department. The decision of the faculty's council includes the appointment of the advisor of the master's dissertation in accordance with Article 98 of the executive regulations of the regulation of the Universities law. Under all circumstances, the registration of the master's dissertation is extinguished after the lapse of 3 years from the date of its registration except when the faculty's council agrees to maintain the registration for another period it specifies based on the advisor's report until it takes the opinion of the competent department's council.
- The maximum limit of extending the periods of registration for the master's degree is a similar period of the one provided for in the by laws (3 years) provided that this is applied at the end the original registration period provided for in the faculty's by laws.
- The student must print his dissertation in case it is determined to be fit for discussion and 20 copies of the dissertation must be presented to the faculty some of them are distributed to the members of the judgment committee and the remaining ones are kept in the library for the University's exchanges.
- It is shown in the certificate of the master's degree the postgraduate studies diploma the student has obtained in addition to the subject matter of the master's dissertation he has presented.

The student's success is announced with one of the following grades:

Master's degree in law.

Master's degree in law with the grade: Good

Master's degree in law with the grade: very Good



PhD Degree Stage

Conditions of obtaining PhD:

- He has obtained 2 of the postgraduate studies diplomas provided that one of these two diplomas is in the public or private law from one of the faculties of law in the Arab Republic of Egypt or the master's degree or equivalent diplomas or scientific degrees from another recognized scientific institution.
- He has carried out innovated researches on a topic approved by the council of the postgraduate studies and research upon the proposal of the faculty's council for two years at least from the date of the approval by the faculty's council of the registration of the subject matter.
- He must pass the English or French test by a committee annually composed by a decision of the faculty's council and he must be good at using the computer according to the rules and criteria set by the faculty's council.
- He must present the results of his researches in a dissertation accepted by the judgment committee and it is discussed in public.
- The student is entitled to choose the subject matter of his dissertation provided that it is connected to one of the diplomas or the master's degree he obtained.
- The student must present the application of the registration of the dissertation's subject matter to the Dean of the faculty. Then, it is submitted to the faculty's council after taking the opinion of the competent department and the decision of the faculty's council includes the appointment of the advisor of the preparation of the dissertation.
- The dissertation's advisor presents an annual report to the faculty's council at the end of each academic year about the range of the student's progress in his research. In light of this report, the registration of this dissertation may be cancelled according to Article 102 of the executive regulations of the regulation of universities law.
- Under all circumstances, the registration of the dissertation is extinguished after the lapse of 6 years from the date of its registration except when the faculty's council agrees to maintain this registration for one period or more it specifies based on the advisor's report and after taking the opinion of the competent department's council.

The success of the student is announced with one of the following grades:

- Doctor in Law
- Doctor in Law with the grade : Good
- Doctor in Law with the grade : Very Good

The Judgment committee is entitled to grant the honor's degree to whoever obtains the grade: Very Good. Also, it is entitled to decide to exchange the dissertation with the other universities in case this dissertation deserves that.

It is shown in the PhD certificate the postgraduate studies diplomas or the master's dissertation obtained by the student and the subject matter of the dissertation he presented in addition to the grade he obtained.



Post Graduate Diplomas

Application Requirements:

- All applicants must obtain a license degree in Law from one of the Egyptian universities or obtain an equivalent certificate from another accredited scientific institute. The faculty council has the right to identify the number of applicants for each diploma.
- Each student prepares a research in the subject he/she wants to apply to under the supervision of one or more of the staff members.

Subjects of the Different Diplomas According to the Faculty Statute:

- Private Law Diploma
- Public Law Diploma
- International Law Diploma
- Criminal Law Diploma

Success grades are as follow:

- Excellent 90% or Higher
- Very Good 85% to less than 90%
- Good 75% to less than 85%
- Pass 70% to less than 75%
